Map Your Backyard Land Cover!



Let's make a land cover map. You can use your backyard, a park, or some other outdoor area. Watch out for roads, and choose an area with varied cover.

- 1. Mark off an area about 10 steps by 10 steps. Use normal steps—no baby steps, no super huge ones. If needed, use two steps for each square to cover a bit more ground.
- 2. As you move along, notice what's covering the ground. Do you see grass? Trees? Pavement? Water?
- 3. Move back over the land and carefully draw or write what the land cover looks like on the grid to the right.
- 4. Now, count how many squares are mostly covered in each of the land cover categories below.
