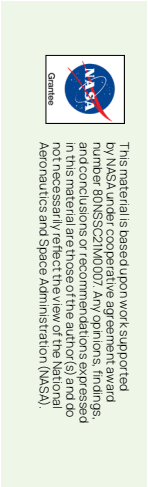
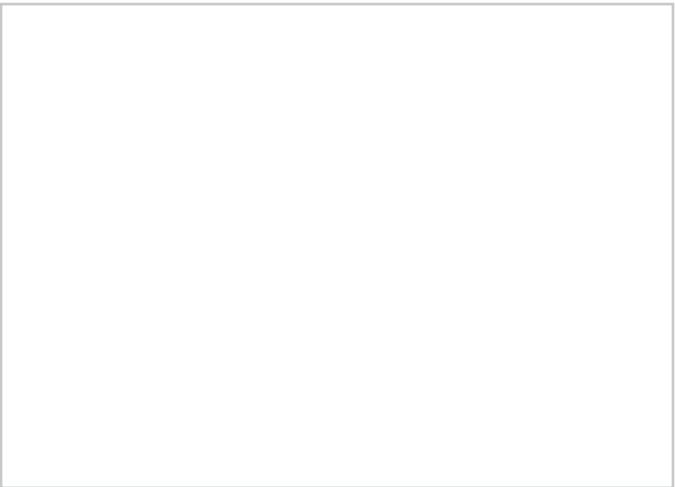
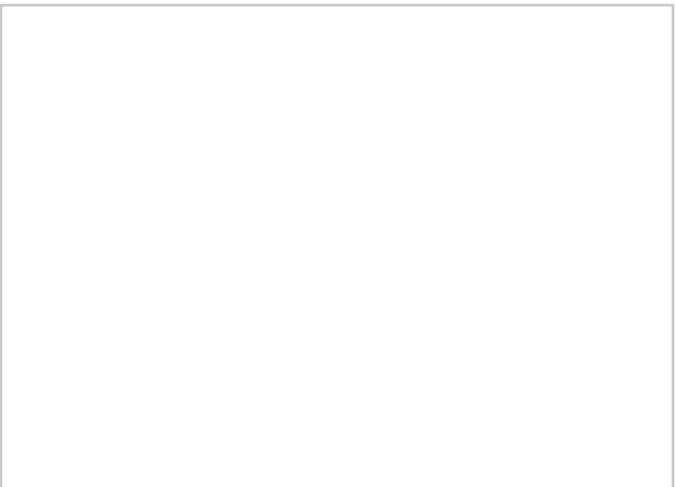
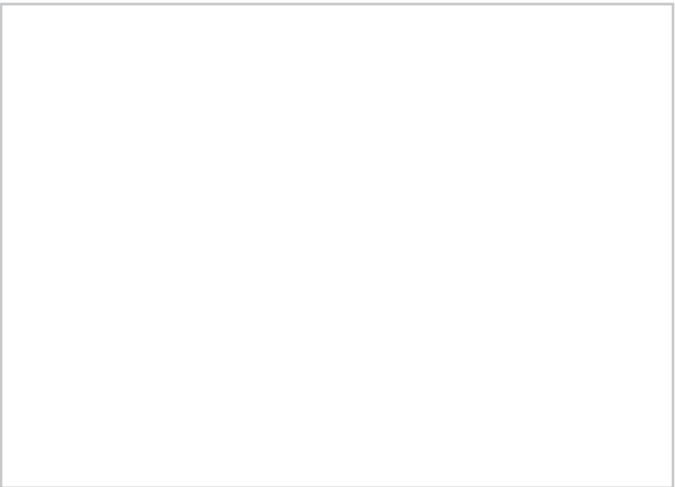
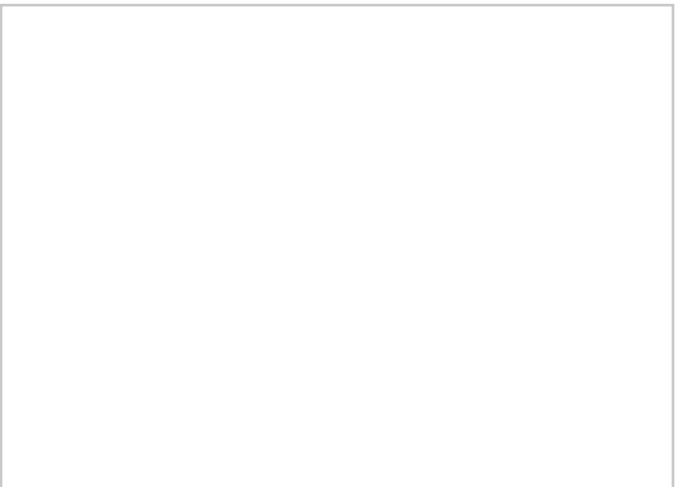
Spark conversations about shared values
