Please fill out this application to be considered for a 2014 NanoDays physical kit. Applications for physical kits will be accepted from October 1 through December 1, 2013. A total of 250 kits are available for distribution. Kits will be shipped in January 2014.

The NISE Network also offers a digital download version of the NanoDays kit, which includes instructions, supply lists, marketing materials, and multimedia files. Consider downloading a digital kit if you do not meet [eligibility criteria](#); please note that K-12 schools and locations outside the United States are not eligible for physical kits. You may also consider a digital kit if you are affiliated with an organization that does not hold public events, are collaborating with another institution holding an event, or want to create multiple copies of print resources.
